His move to his new home at Buderim Views became all the more poignant when Arthur's granddaughter discovered Arthur's father was also residing at the facility, in a manner of speaking. An historical print of Arthur's father dating back to 1908 at the Buderim Tennis Club features in the Buderim Views new library. The library's collection consists of several framed images sourced from the Buderim Historical Society.

"The historical photos are a real talking point, and every visitor to our facility is drawn to them" says Dianne Weeks, Manager of Buderim Views.

"We were assisted by John at Country Frames who sourced the best images from the local historical society, enlarged them and enhanced them with paprika coloured inlays and name plates."

Arthur's wife, Marion and daughter Sally knew how thrilled Arthur would be that his father's memory is being kept alive for others to enjoy. For Arthur and his family, it was just another cue which helped them decide that Buderim Views was the right place for him to move to.

From his room, which overlooks his beloved Buderim where he and his family have lived for generations, Mr. Townsend happily reflects on his family's rich history in the area, and is delighted that he can still live near his family and friends whilst receiving the care he needs.

Buderim Views opened its doors to its first residents in March and is now home to around 20 residents, with staff being kept busy each week with a structured intake program of new residents. Buderim Views is a state-of-the-art aged care residence comprising high care, low care, respite and Dementia specific beds. The new facility compliments Prime Trust's six retirement villages located in the region, including the well-known Hibiscus Retirement Resorts.
